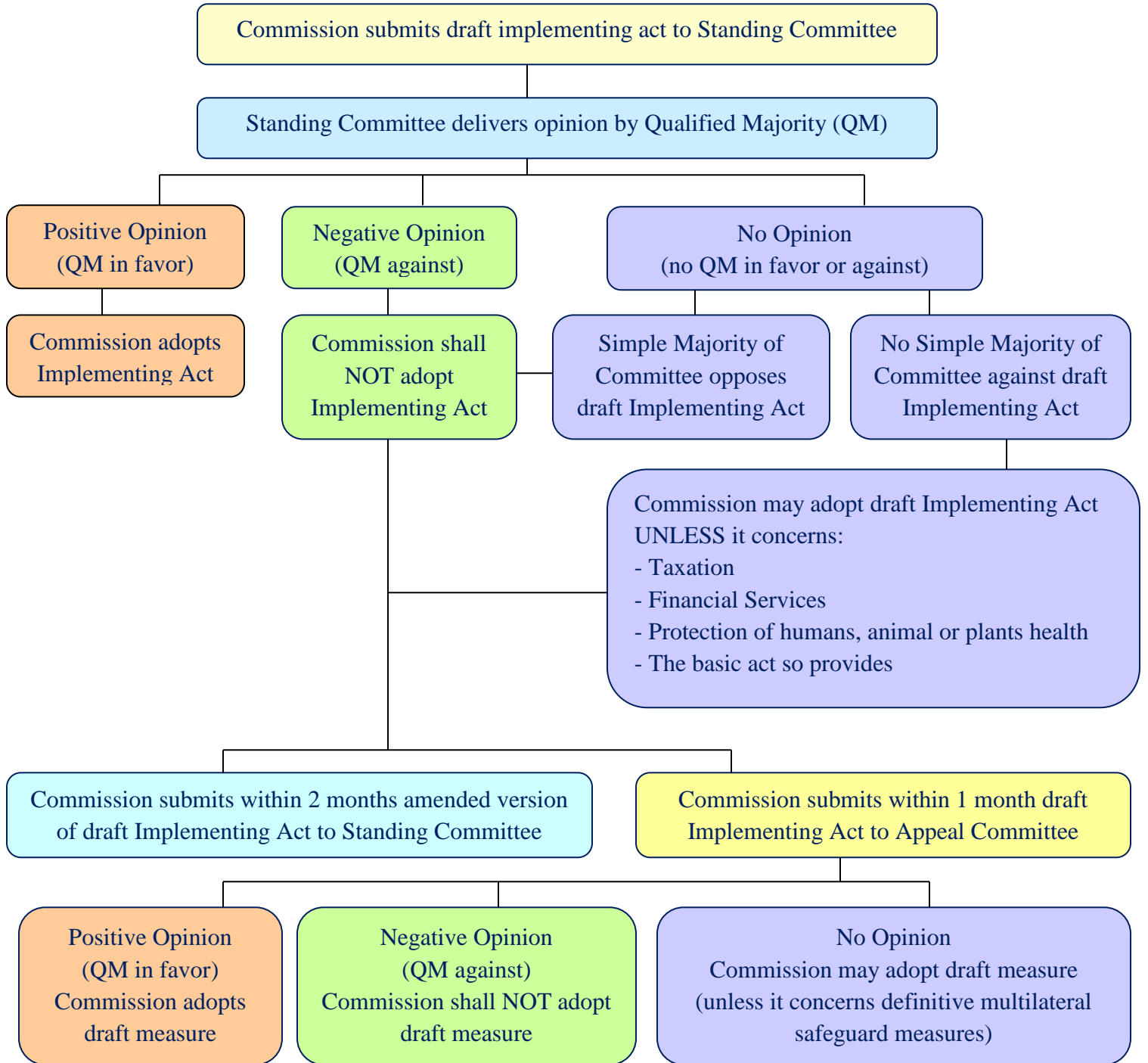


## EXAMINATION PROCEDURE

Established by “New Comitology” Regulation 182/2011 (repealing Decision 1999/468)



### Footnotes:

- Appeal Committee is composed of Member States representatives at the “appropriate level” and chaired by the Commission, delivers its opinion by qualified majority
- Qualified Majority = support of at least 16 Member States representing at least 65 percent of EU population
- The Commission may adopt draft measures without delay to avoid significant disruptions of the agriculture markets and submit the act immediately to the Appeal Committee. If the Appeal Committee delivers a negative opinion, the Commission must repeal the act.
